

Dressing like a Tudor


In Tudor times the law dictated who could wear what colours and types of clothing. A poor person would wear wool and linen in rather dull colours.

Girls:

- Always wore dresses
- Skirt over dress
- Apron over skirt
- Waistcoat
- Had hair covered with cap or cloth
- Long socks
- School shoes

- Waistcoat

- Belt
